	Is associated with one or more of the following: Los Angeles Home Telephone and Telegraph, Sunset Telephone, Pacific Telephone and Telegraph, California Telephone, Southern California Bell Telephone
	Later examples may still be in use
	May also be significant under a theme within the Architecture context
	May be a rare example of the type
	More research needed

	Resource does not retain sufficient CDFs/Associative Features
INTEGRITY CONSIDERATIONS:	Early and rare examples may have a greater degree of alterations
	Should retain integrity of Location, Feeling, and Association from the period of significance
