PERIOD OF SIGNIFICANCE	1939 - 1960
ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS:	Is one of the four air raid siren design types - rotating, birdhouse, wire spool and flattened birdhouse
	Represents an important phase in the history of civil defense during World War II and the Cold War
	Was constructed between 1939 and 1960
	More research needed
	Resource does not meet Eligibility Standards
	No Eligibility Standards checked
CHARACTER DEFINING/ASSOCIATIVE FEATURES:	Most are installed on a building, traffic light, or a freestanding support pole
	Retains the essential physical features of the type from the period of significance
	More research needed
	No CDFs/Associative Features checked
	Resource does not retain sufficient CDFs/Associative Features
INTEGRITY CONSIDERATIONS:	May be overgrown with plants and trees
	Setting may have changed (surrounding buildings and land uses)
	Should retain integrity of Location, Feeling, Design and Association from the period of significance
